General Job Description and Requirements

The Camp Counselor will be under the supervision of the Camp Director. He/She will be responsible for planning, organizing, implementing and supervising a variety of activities and programs for children in summer camp programs. This person may also be called up to assist with special events held throughout the summer

Other job responsibilities include program planning, equipment inventory and maintenance (including cleaning), facility supervision, and general office procedures. A week of orientation and training will give this person a clear understanding of the Waterville Valley Recreation Department's overall mission, values, goals, and procedures.

Applicant should be capable of strenuous physical activity and enjoy the outdoors as many of the programs are active in nature and relate to the outdoors. General knowledge of sports and games is preferred. Skills in other program areas, such as arts & crafts and music, is helpful.

Camp Counselors must have a positive attitude and should be enthusiastic, understanding, and creative. Must be capable of leading and working with all age groups however this person will work mostly with children. Flexibility, pleasant personality, good organizational skills and ability to meet and deal with the public are a must.

Applicant must be able to walk, run, stand, stoop, kneel, lift up to 25 pounds, speak English clearly, and be able to see.
